

WINDSOR TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The recessed meeting of the Windsor Township Board of Supervisors reconvened at 12:55 p.m. on March 19, 2009 at the Windsor Township Administrative Office.

Mrs. Gunnet advised that the employees were aware that the Township had hired a consultant to perform a study to determine whether the Township was providing competitive wages and benefits to our employees. She then introduced Chet Mosteller of Mosteller & Associates as the consultant who performed the study.

Mr. Mosteller discussed his background for performing such a study and how he arrived at the average market study wages that were distributed to the employees. He also explained various options that the Township has for bringing employees that are making more or less than the average market study wage amount closer to the average wage. Mr. Mosteller also advised that the Township provides its employees with a good insurance package. He added that there may be a need in the future to increase the amount that the employees contribute towards insurance.

Several questions were asked by employees that were answered by Mr. Mosteller.

The Board thanked Mr. Mosteller for his work on the study.
