

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FIRE HYDRANTS
AND WATER SUPPLY FOR FIRE PROTECTION
IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WINDSOR, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Windsor, County of York, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Windsor Township Fire Hydrant Ordinance.

SECTION II.

The following words when used in this Ordinance are defined as follows:

A. Protected Area. Those lots or tracts of land fronting along any highways, streets, roads and alleys or portions thereof within the Township which are serviced by public water, maintained at such pressures approved by the Fire Insurance Underwriters and where Fire Hydrants have been installed within 780 feet of such lots or tracts of land.

B. Districts. Protected areas as defined which are serviced by the Red Lion Municipal Water Company and/or the York Water Company.

C. Assessment. Annual levy by Township Supervisors for the payment of such fire protection based on cost of placement, replacement, operation, maintenance, repairs, and other costs or charges incidental thereto, upon property situate in protected areas, based upon the assessment thereof for county purposes.

D. Exempted Property. No assessment shall be levied against any farm land or land used as an aviation field or against other property in a district not benefited thereby.

SECTION III.

That the Supervisors of Windsor Township shall cause to be annually assessed the cost of fire protection service by an equal assessment upon all property not exempted herein, within a protected area of a district of the Township benefited thereby, based upon the assessment of such property for county purposes.

SECTION IV.

Such assessment shall be collected in the same manner as other real estate taxes. The Township Collector shall receive the same commission as on the Township Tax.

SECTION V.

The Township Treasurer shall receive all such assessments collected for fire protection, and keep the same in a separate account, and shall pay the same out for the cost thereof only upon orders signed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and attested by the Township Secretary.

SECTION VI.

The Township Treasurer shall make a report to the Auditors of the Township annually.

SECTION VII.

Any Ordinance, or part of any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION VIII.

If any section, subsection or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or of any part thereof, it being the intent of the Supervisors that the remaining portions of the Ordinance shall be of full force and effect.
