

WINDSOR TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
SPECIAL MEETING
January 12, 2022

1. The special meeting of the Windsor Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 3:30 p.m. by Chairman Kathy Kerchner.

Those present: Kathy Kerchner, Rodney Sechrist, Jennifer Gunnet, Kipp Allison, Lynn Cheeseman, Craig Lusco, Kim Moyer, Troy Dehoff and Jeremy Trout.

2. The pledge of allegiance was recited.
3. There was a discussion with each of the candidates that had submitted resumes to fill the vacancy on the Board of Supervisors. Those candidates were: Lynn Cheeseman, Craig Lusco and Kim Moyer. Each candidate was asked questions and were given the opportunity to ask questions of the Board. Each candidate was asked if they met the requirements in the Second Class Township Code that they have been residents of the Township for at least one (1) year and were a registered voter. All of the candidates responded that they met those requirements.

Mrs. Kerchner thanked each candidate for expressing their interest in the vacancy. An executive session for personnel matters would be held after this meeting and that an announcement would be made at the January 17, 2022 meeting.

4. Troy Dehoff of the Windsor Township Sewer Department asked the Board to reconsider the operator for the 10th winter maintenance route that was discussed at the December 20, 2021 meeting. A lengthy discussion followed. It was stated that if Mr. Sematoske was needed to respond to a sewer emergency while he was performing winter maintenance that the other winter maintenance operators would fill in to complete his route. The Board advised that they would like to give this a try for this winter and that the 10th winter maintenance route operator be Mr. Sematoske.
5. There was no public comment.
6. There was no Supervisor comment.
7. The meeting adjourned into an executive session to discuss personnel at 5:50 p.m.
