Please mark your calendars now and plan to attend Cabin Creek Watershed Day on Saturday, May 14, 2016 between 11 AM and 3 PM (rain or shine) at Windsor Wonderland. The theme for Cabin Creek Watershed Day is "Know Your Water, Know Your Watershed." Windsor Township and Red Lion Municipal Authority (RLMA) are hosting this special event as part of our joint, cooperative effort to improve water quality in the Cabin Creek watershed.

You and your neighbors are being invited to this event because you receive drinking water from RLMA and your neighborhood is located within and drains to the Cabin Creek Watershed, the main source of your drinking water.

The York County Master Watershed Stewards will host numerous activities for residents of all ages, including:

- Build a creek for elementary school children
- Fish printing stencil a fish on a t-shirt or canvas bag. Please bring your own shirt or canvas bag for fish printing.
- Brief talks on the importance of ground water, watersheds and the simple things you can do to reduce storm water runoff
- Rain barrel construction and installation demonstrations

Food and drink will also be available for purchase during the event at the snack bar.

We are also offering all residents the chance to pre-order a rain barrel and pick it up on Cabin Creek Watershed Day. Each rain barrel costs \$21.20 and can be paid by check or cash at pick up. You are welcome to order as many rain barrels as you need.

There is also an opportunity for teenagers and adults to participate that same day in the installation of storm drain markers on all storm water inlets in your neighborhood.
